I am thinking that your father, Jimmy Treadway, was (?) maybe a brother to my beloved grandmother or cousin, anyway, I feel sure your father was kin to my set of Treadways

because I know my grandmother had a brother name Tommy ("Tom") that lived in Mountain City and he had a son named Randy & a daughter named Shirley that use to come to the Roark, Treadway, Ownes, Gurley, Doyle family reunions. Shirley took over the planning for the reunion after our double first cousin, Thelma (Lowe) Ownes, had to give it up after many successful years of planning it due to health condition and the distance of living from Bristol, Va/Tn, I believe (?) Haskins, Tn., (someplace west of Knoxville, Tn).

There is a William (?L, if memory serves me right) Tredway (notice the difference in the spelling of Tredway, this one is Tredway and yours & ours is Treadway) who went to Tusculum College, now University, back in the (?) early part of the 1900's. I believe he & his family was from upper north, like (? New Jersey, or (?) New York, or (?) Pa. William (?L) Tredway died, I believe if memory serves me right in 1950 and he was a lawyer in New Jersey, again, if memory serves me right. William (?L) Tredway is a Benefactor at Tusculum University in Greeneville, Tn.
